A Guide on How to Save twitter DM Videos



Using Video Downloader helper extension

- Go to the Video Downloader Helper page on the Chrome Web Store and click Add to Chrome. Confirm the installation by clicking Add extension.
- Open the Twitter DM that contains the video you want to save. Click the play button to start the video.
- Click the Video Downloader Helper icon on the top right corner of your browser. You will see a list of available video formats and resolutions. Choose the one you want and click Download.
- The video will be saved to your default download folder. You can also change the download location and filename by right-clicking the video and choosing Save Link.



Using HD Video Downloader extension

- Go to the HD Video Downloader page on the Chrome Web Store and click Add to Chrome. Confirm the installation by clicking Add extension.
- Open the Twitter DM that contains the video you want to save. Click the play button to start the video.
- Click the HD Video Downloader icon on the top right corner of your browser. You will see a pop-up window with the video details. Click the Download button next to the video quality you want.
- The video will be saved to your default download folder. You can also change the download location and filename by right-clicking the video and choosing Save Link.



Saving Videos using VLC Media Player

- Download and install the VLC media player from the official website.
- Open the Twitter DM that contains the video you want to save. Right-click the video and choose Copy video address.
- Open VLC and go to Media, then Convert/Save. In the Open Media window, click the Network tab and paste the copied video URL in the Please enter a network URL box. Click Convert/Save.
- In the Convert window, choose the destination file name and location for the output video. Click the Profile drop-down menu and select the desired video format and quality.
- You can also click the Edit selected profile button to adjust the output settings. Click Start. • VLC will start downloading and converting the video. You can see the progress on the
- VLC interface. Once the process is complete, you can find the video in the destination folder.



Using Screen recording on an Android

- Swipe down from the top of your screen to open the Quick Settings panel. Tap the screen recorder icon.
- A pop-up window will appear with some options. You can choose the sound source (internal, external, or both), the video quality (low, medium, or high), and the Show Touches option (on or off).
- Open the Twitter DM that contains the video you want to save. Tap the play button to start the video. You can also adjust the volume, brightness, and orientation of your screen as needed.
- To stop recording, swipe down from the top of your screen and tap the Screen Recorder icon again.



sing Screen Recording on an iOS I

- the + button next to Screen Recording to add it to your Control Center.
- Swipe up from the bottom of your screen (or swipe down from the top right corner on an iPhone X or later) to open the Control Center. Tap the
- screen recording icon. Open the Twitter DM that contains the video you want to save. Tap the play button to start the video.
- To stop recording, tap the red status bar at the top of your screen and tap Stop. Alternatively, you can open the Control Center and tap the Screen Recording icon again.
